

350 Delegates Due To Attend 16th National CP Convention

OVER 350 DELEGATES and alternates from all parts of the country are expected to be present when the Communist Party opens its 16th national convention on Saturday morning, Feb. 9. The convention will continue through Tuesday, Lincoln's Birthday.

The sessions will be held at Chateau Gardens, 105 East Houston Street.

First items on the convention agenda for Saturday will be the election of committees, and a keynote speech by Eugene Dennis, general secretary.

The remainder of the convention will be devoted to the discussion and adoption of the main Draft Resolution, a party constitution, miscellaneous resolutions, and the election of a new national committee. The Draft Resolution has been discussed for several months within the party.

On Saturday night, the New York Freedom of the Press committee has invited all out-of-town delegates to the convention to be its guests at the 33d anniversary ball of the Daily Worker. The ball will be held at Chateau Gardens.
