

Flynn Thanks Supporters

Elizabeth Gurley Flynn, Communist national committeewoman, yesterday thanked her friends and neighbors who participated in her campaign for the City Council in the 24th district. Daniel S. Weiss, Democrat, was reelected with 41,902 votes to represent the district for another term.

The vote for the other candidate: Henry Del Rosso, Republican, 17,591; W. L. Kirshenbaum, Liberal, 9,965; Elizabeth Flynn, Peoples' Rights, 710.

"At the outset," Miss Flynn declared, "I want to thank all who have participated in this election campaign—and that includes many friends and neighbors, those who have signed the petitions, those who carried on the daily work, and the many comrades and supporters. The election campaign had a number of high points.

"First, the petition campaign was a contribution to the civil liberties of all Americans as well as to the legality of our party and to the rights of Communists.

"Second, we brought forward our position in street meetings, radio programs leaflets and literature.

"In this we contributed to the continuing struggle for the Sharkey - Brown - Isaacs bill, decent housing for all, an end to all discrimination, better schools and better health.

"Third, there was a healthy spirit of unity. I enjoyed tremendously the reappearance of Benjamin J. Davis and myself at the radio stations, as well as the good work of all comrades and friends in the campaign.

"Fourth, I think we must do much more to follow up this campaign and give more attention to the problems of the Negro people and the Puerto Ricans in the life of our city."
