## Suggests Victory Press Conference

Editor, Daily Worker:

Following a report and discussion about the D.W. readers conference of Oct. 26th, the Crown Heights (Brooklyn) Section Committee submits the following for your consideration:

First, while we regard the conference and response thereto as generally good, both ideologically and materially, we believe too little time and effort was given to insuring its full and complete success. Particularly did we note that on the very first day of the four-page DW's appearance and despite the conference announcement's being editorialized, more prominence was given to a critic's review of a Soviet author's fictional work. It is our opinion that both we and the Daily Worker can live with or without such reviews, but our survival will be enhanced and the future of the D.W. and its readers be made happier if the four pages we must abide with at the moment are filled with politically-nutritious, meaty articles, instead of giving a half of the feature and editorial page

to book reviews. . . .

Besides being critical, we want to propose something constructive:

(a) We propose, for a not-too-distant date, a VICTORY CONFERENCE.

(b) Such conference should not be a Run-of-the-Mill type with too many reports. Instead, one collective and concise report. The rest of the time given to the delegated and voluntary readers. Not that the leadership of the Party or members of the Press Committee should be denied the right to speak but rather that democratic procedure shall prevail and equal time given to all who take the floor to contribute ideas, opinions and cash and subs, new and renewed. Such grassroots action, we feel, will best assure the return of the four lost pages to the D.W., as well as the honest core in the army of apostates from Socialism back into our fold.

(c) When the date of such a VICTORY CONFERENCE is set, the Party, at all levels, must be activated in what must be regarded as a LIFE or DEATH struggle for survival of our papers. The Victory Conference item should be on the agenda of every meeting.

From that conference, think how much better we can face the future and serve those who, like ourselves, want a world at peace, an America without Clinton, Little Rock, Levittown and Dixiecrat hate gangs and thus, in action, rejuvenate and rebuild our party. . . .
