

Martial Law Courts Set Up In Hungary

BUDAPEST, Jan. 13.—The Hungarian government today authorized formation of special courts to handle cases under martial law.

The decree authorized punishment up to death for these "offenses against the state":

1. Instigating workers to strike.
2. Intentional disturbance of workers in "indispensable" plants.
3. Entering plants or factories owned by the people without permission.
4. Damaging public utility plants or supplies.
