Paper Says U. S. Reds Do Not Back Soviet on Hungary

An editorial in The Daily Worker, New York Communist newspaper, this morning denied reports published in some newspapers that the Communist party of the United States had defended Soviet aggression and genocide in Hungary.

"The American Communist party has not apologized for the Soviet action in Hungary, nor has this paper," it stated.

"The National Committee of the party on Tuesday categorically said that the Oct. 24 decision of the [Erno] Gero Government to call upon Soviet troops was 'a tragic error for which the Soviet Union must also take responsibility,'" the editorial continued.

"As for the second intervention of Nov. 4, the National Committee refused to justify it, while declaring that 'neither do we join the condemnation of these actions' since there are no 'ready answers' yet to provide a 'final judgment,'" it said.
