The "spokesman" of the political bureau, Raymond Guyot, sent a communication to the Central Committee of the French Communist Party, which was immediately transmitted by the press agencies to the entire world, in which the directors of the French Communist Party considered as urgent a world conference of all Communist parties and workers.

That is his duty.

Another fact is the accumulation of slander and insults directed not only against the Marxists-Leninists of France or our Communist Party of Belgium, which Guyot considers as a "false party", but also against the comrades who have eliminated the revisionist-scissionist leaders such as in Peru and in Ceylon, and against the Chinese Communist Party, the Albanian Labor Party, and all the other Marxist-Leninist parties on the five continents, which Guyot does not dare mention. It goes without saying that our party will reply as it

should, through a party document, to this new and gross public

attack.

Interviewed by the correspondent in Paris of the R.T.B. on the point of knowing whether the world conference envisaged by Guyot would include the new Marxist-Leninist parties, such as the Communist Party of Belgium and the old parties -- such as the Chinese Communist Party -- Guyot has been willing to give his consent to participation by the Chinese party, but he has maintained silence regarding the first part of the question ...

That Raymond Guyot or Francois Billoux explain to us how they have dared to lower the prestige of their party even to publicly attacking a brother party in the interview granted last summer to the Deutsche Nazionale und Soldaten Zeitung (The German National and Soldiers' Newspaper), this fascist and neo-Nazi rag of the worst German avengers.
