On Feb. 15-16 the Revolutionary Student Brigade will hold its first Western Regional Conference. This letter is an invitation to

you to attend the conference.

The world today is in great turmoil. National Liberation movements continue to win victories against imperialism. From Vietnam to the Philippines to Palestine to Guinea-Bissau, the people of the Third World are winning independence from the U.S. and other imperial-

ist powers.

The American people are fighting back, too. With the largest strike wave since World War II, with thousands demonstrating against police repression, and with the growing fight against outbacks, the American workers and students are organizing to fight against the imperialists (the handful of monopoly capitalists who rule this country).

The Revolutionary Student Brigade believes that students play an important role in the revolutionary movement in the U.S. We see the need to take the energy, anger, and understanding that students have and struggle together as a unified force. We must organise and

fight to build the anti-imperialist movement.

The Revolutionary Student Brigade is a nationwide, anti-imperialist student organization of all nationalities. We are organized around two principles:

1) Support for national liberation strugglas abroad, as exempli-

fied by the NLF/PRG of Vietnam,

2) Support for the struggles of oppressed people at home. And we are united around the fact that the attacks coming down at

home and abroad come from one system-U.S. imperialism.

Now is the time for all of us to get together-members of the Revolutionary Student Brigade, independent anti-imperialist student organizations, foreign student organizations, and all progressive students. We need to talk about the struggles we've built and the issues to build around in the future. We have to sum-up our victories as well as our mistakes. It will be a time for people to understand what the R.S.B. is about and to contribute their experiences in the fight to build the revolutionary student movement. There will also be representatives from other organizations fighting imperialism--Vets, workers, Third World organizations, and Communist organizations--so that we can learn how to join our struggles with theirs.

We can't afford to be isolated, disunited and cynical about our strength. The system of imperialism is crumbling and we must unite

to wipe it off the face of the earth!
