And PleasE don't send anymare GENERAL BOKERS"

Historically, the capitalists have attempted to destroy the leaders of the working class. The case of General Baker is no different. Gen Baker has been employed at the Ford Rouge Plant since September of 73. On April 15,75 General Baker was discharged by the Ford Motor Co. for "securing employment under the use of an alias."

His discharge is an outright violation of the UAW International contract for the Ford Dept. The established practice for the Ford Dept is that there is a twelve month limitation of falsification of application. As established in the Umpire Opinion A-184, May4, 1954: Why has the Ford Motor Co. chosen to break an agreement that has been on the books for 30 years? One reason is that 'since his employment at Ford in '73, Gen Baker has been in the lead of the struggle to build the Dearborn Assembly Flant Unemployment Committee. Local 600, into a fighting committee for jobs and peace. Also, Gen Baker has a life history of fighting for all of the democratic rights of the working class. In 1968 Gen was fired from Dodge Main, Locality, for participating in an "unlawful" work stoppage. Chrysler Corp. and the UAW chose to see only the leadership of General Baker. He and another Negro worker were the only two of those pa ticipating who were fired. General Baker then became one of the founding members of the Dodge Revolutionary Union Movement (DRUM) which went on to lead many of the struggles of Negro workers against the historic, white chauvenist discrimination that has been perpetuated against Negro workers since their entry into large factories.

other workers from different plants saw the need for clearer and stronger direction of a divided working class. They knew this could only be accomplished through the formation of a true, fighting Communist Party. In September of 74 the Communist habor Party of the USNA was formed. The CLP is proud to have a worker of General Baker's stature as a member. His case is not that of our individual fighting ford Motor co., but a fight for the democratic rights of the working class and smash all Fascist, Capitalist attacks on the working class. If General Baker's case is lost, it will be one more victory for the Capitalist in their attempt to destroy the democratic rights for which the working class has fought and died. We must support General Baker, and resist and struggle against all attacks on the working class.


Nothing to loose but our chains . . .
