GREENSBORO, N.C.—“Long Live the CWP!” Signe Waller shouted as she crouched over the body of her husband, defying a hail of bullets. Comrade Jim Waller, Communist Workers Party (CWP) Central Committee member and National President of the Trade Union Educational League, was shot and killed by three professional assassins as they braved a hail of bullets during a November 3 anti-Klan demonstration.

They Died Fighting for the Dictatorship of the Proletariat Rather Than Live as Slaves...

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by the hired hands of the bourgeoisie, the KKK and Nazis. At Jim's side, with the instinct of all class-conscious proletarian fighters, comrade Cesar Cauce rushed forward armed with his courage, bare fists and a picket sign. Beating the brains out of a scum KKKer with his sign, he turned to see comrade Bill Sampson caught in a Klan crossfire. "I'm hit," shouted Bill as he fell to the ground. With his last fighting breath he said, "take the gun and keep firing!" as he handed over the pistol to Cesar. As comrade Cesar started to shoot at the KKK and Nazi scum, he was knocked to the ground from behind, and murdered from behind in cold blood at point blank range by the cowardly killers.

Selflessly risking her life to save the children, comrade Sandy Smith ran through the crowd in the middle of automatic rifle fire, gathering the children to safety. After shoving them into a nearby house, she grabbed a gun from another comrade and came back shooting. Singled out by the bourgeoisie's assassins, she was gunned down.

Michael Nathans, a friend of the Party and a medical doctor, was cold-bloodedly murdered by shots in the head fired by professional assassins, as he was helping other wounded comrades on the ground. For his heroism the Party recruited him hours before he died in the hospital.

The professional and premeditated assassination of Jim Waller, Sandy Smith, Bill Sampson, Cesar Cauce, and Michael Nathans—all members of the Communist Workers Party—was the bloody work of a group of trained murderers using the Klan and the Nazis as a cover. "This was a SWAT-team-like assassination crew; it was not the act of a few crazy Klansmen," said Nelson Johnson, CWP organizer in Greensboro.

The Klan and the Nazis are sick scum, degenerate psychos whom the government uses to do its dirty work for the bourgeoisie. Alone they are spineless cowards, half-crazed jokers parading around in hoods and swastikas. They don't have the guts to attack the Party and the masses in Greensboro without the full backing of the capitalist state apparatus—the local, state and Federal police.

Deliberate Gov't Military Action, Not Spontaneous KKK/Nazi Outburst

This was no spontaneous outburst by Klan members and Nazis—it was a carefully and deliberately planned military operation intent on assassinating CWP leadership, to intimidate the Party and the rising mass consciousness and resistance. First the pigs tried to disarm the Party and set us up for the kill. They had a special ordinance passed

prohibiting us from having weapons there. The fact that the local police left the area just before the gun battle began shows that they were tipped off about the planned assassinations. After they let the assassination squad do their bloody job, then and only then did the pigs return to arrest CWP members for "inciting to riot." About eight vehicles (as contrasted to the reported two) drove up Everitt Street, past the marchers gathered at the Morningside Community Center. The lead car fired into the air to draw the demonstrators towards the front, and at the rear of the car caravan, a car full of Klansmen assassins then fired on demonstrators from the back. In this way they further dispersed the demonstrators and scattered them for government hired sharpshooters to single out leadership there for the kill. The FBI and other government agents succeeded in their military ambush. Four of the CWP 5 were shot either right in the head or in the heart. At least three out of the five martyrs, as well as most of the seriously injured comrades were ambushed by sharpshooters. The remaining others were killed or injured by the Klan and Nazi assassins. Only two vehicles were stopped by the local cops. Immediately after the murders a team of at least two dozen FBI agents were dispatched directly from the White House to seize the evidence and organize the coverup.

Four Party Leaders Executed—Strongest Proof of Government Assassination Plot

Four of the five comrades murdered were leading members of the Party, one a member of the Central Committee. This is the strongest evidence of a premeditated government assassination plot. They were identified, singled out, and assassinated by order. According to the November 6 issue of the Winston-Salem Journal, "Joe Grady of Winston-Salem, Grand Dragon of the White Knights of Liberty... said that one person, who is not a Klansman and whom he did not name, brought most of the weapons to Greensboro. Grady said that Raeford Milano Caudle, who was charged with conspiracy to commit murder in the incident, told him that the man was not supposed to go to the rally point but

knew who was to be shot." Only expert marksmen have the ability to kill so quickly and accurately. Dr. Hudson, the North Carolina chief medical examiner confirmed that the victims were hit in the head and upper body. Yet, in an eyewitness account by Greensboro Daily News reporter Winston Cavin, he says that the Klan/Nazis "didn't really have time to aim for specific targets. They simply fired broadside into a group." Clearly the Klan/Nazis couldn't have murdered four Party leaders out of five and only the state has the resources, organization and trained agents to be able to pull off this military action. The state instigated scum like KKKers and Nazis into a trap like that. The Klan and the Nazis are used as a cover, a diversion for the largest assassination of communists since the Palmer raids in the 1920's.

The attack on the Communist Workers Party leadership shows the desperation of the bourgeoisie in the face of a situation where the American people are waking up like never before. The "American Dream" is being shattered. Workers see no future for themselves and dread the future of their children. Economic and political crises are slapping the masses awake, and more and more are seeing what a stinking corpse capitalism is. The U.S. today is like dry tinder; any spark of resistance from any mass strata or sector

of society could ignite a blaze of revolutionary struggle. Sitting on top of a volcano, the bourgeoisie has to squash any mass resistance to preserve their rule. The recent attack on the CWP is only the beginning of a renewed and larger attack by the bourgeoisie against the inevitable resistance of workers and oppressed people, an attack that will make the Palmer raids in the 1920's, the McCarthy era of the 50's and the suppression of the Black Panther Party in the 60's look pale in comparison.

Party Can't Be Bribed, Bullied or Tricked Into Killing Other Groups

The assassination of our five comrades is more than a fight between the Communist Workers Party and a few racists. It's a fight between the Party, representing the masses' interests, and

the government, representing the interests of a handful of criminals—the monopoly capitalists. The Communist Workers Party is the only one that is leading and can lead the U.S. people to overthrow the bourgeoisie and end their oppression. This is clear in North Carolina. The Party is in the forefront of the masses' struggle, from fighting to free the Wilmington 40 to beating back the "competency tests" to forging fighting unions in the mainly unorganized Black Belt South. The bourgeoisie shakes with fear at the sight of the Party, because they know that we can't be bribed or bullied, or get instigated into a killing spree with other groups, like between the Black Panthers and Ron Karenga of U.S. Organization in the late 60's, that we won't let anything stand in the way of overthrowing their vicious rule through armed insurrection and establishing the dictatorship of the proletariat.

Not the First Time Gov't Attacked Communist Workers Party

This isn't the first time the state/FBI has attacked the CWP. Two years ago, Jan Gusner, a member of the Workers Viewpoint Organization was kidnapped twice, cut up and raped by a sick gang of perverted low-life headed by an FBI agent. And this past April, six squad cars of police busted into a Greensboro comrade's home pretending to be searching for a prison escape. Holding guns to the baby's head, the pigs ransacked the place then split. It turned out that the person they were supposedly looking for had gone to Florida with the pigs' permission. When the comrades filed suit against this harassment, the judge let the pigs off, claiming it was an "honest mistake." No, this isn't the first attack on the CWP and it won't be the last. It will be intensified and the only way to fight it

is to push out broad exposures and to create public opinion against the bourgeoisie and their agents.

While we mourn the murder of our comrades in Greensboro, we aren't afraid of the bourgeoisie's attack because we know we can beat them back and in the process thousands of staunch proletarian warriors will rally to the CWP's banner and the sympathy of the vast majority of U.S. people will be won. This is already happening. Revolutionary martyrs in a just cause like the CWP 5 can never die in vain. For every one of these working class fighters who sacrifice their lives in fierce battle against the bourgeoisie, tens of thousands will step forward to fill the ranks. The CWP 5 Enrollment, the Party membership drive in honor of the five heroes, will be the most successful ever.

The masses are looking for leadership, and today they are looking for the CWP to take up the leadership. We must boldly extend our hand and push forward like never before. Our work must combine the broadest revolutionary sweep with tight organization. This is the only way to turn this country upside down, bust out the masses' deep anger and frustration, and direct it at a clear target—the monopoly capitalist class of Rockefellers and Morgans. □

Greensboro Massacre: Premeditated Gov't Assassination of Communist Workers Party Leaders

The assassination of five Communist Workers Party members Saturday, November 3rd, was a combined attack by Nazi-Klansmen and U.S. government agents.

How Did The Nazi/Klansmen Find the Rally?

The publicly announced starting point of the rally was the Windsor Center. The Communist Workers Party chose the actual starting point of the march, however, to be the Morningside Houses housing project. The Communist Workers Party then filed for a permit to demonstrate with the Greensboro Police Department. The Police Department were the only persons, other than the march organizers, to know the true location of the rally. None-the-less the Nazi-Klan caravan knew the exact location of the rally and drove directly to the site ½ hour before the rally was scheduled to begin. Obviously, someone in the Police Department told the Nazi-Klan caravan where the rally was to be held.

Disarming the Communist Workers Party

The Greensboro Police Department issued a specific ordinance denying the Communist Workers Party the right to carry open or concealed weapons at this demonstration. The police guaranteed that the marchers would be disarmed, and set-up the Communist Workers Party for the kill.

Why Weren't Police At The Rally

The police were not at the rally because someone in the Police Department tipped them off not to be there. The Police Department has issued a number of lies and conflicting reports to explain why they withdrew from the rally prior to the assassinations.

First, Police Chief W.E. Swing says in a news report dated November 5th, that police did not attend the rally because Communist Workers Party Nelson Johnson told the police not to come, "Johnson and other march organizers told officers to stay away, [editor's emphasis] (*Greensboro Record*, Nov. 5). However, in a news report dated November 4th, Chief Swing stated that "Johnson wouldn't talk to officers and became belligerent." The truth is that Nelson Johnson and other Communist Workers Party members did not talk to the police, and told them neither to come or not to come. Police Chief Swing is telling a big lie, groping at an excuse to cover for why the police withdrew from the rally prior to the assassinations.

Second, Police Captain Hampton said that the police did not come to the rally because "We don't, as a normal routine, sit in front of the site of a peaceable, legal, legitimate gathering." (*Greensboro Daily News*, Nov. 4th). Did the police really expect a "peaceful" demonstration as Captain Hampton says or did they expect violence? "Yes,

we felt there could be some violence", (Police Chief Swing. The *Greensboro Record*, Nov. 5) In fact, the *Greensboro Record* reported that "police had extra men on duty Saturday, including the riot-trained tactical squad . . ."

Clearly, the police expected a violent confrontation with the Klan, they even had the riot squad on duty. Still, the police withdrew their forces from the Anti-Klan rally and allowed the Nazi-Klan caravan to pass unchecked into the site of the rally. Again, someone in the Police Department was tipped-off not to come to the rally.

Party Leadership Executed: Strongest Evidence Of Government Plot

The strongest evidence of a premeditated government attack on the Communist Workers Party is that four of the five comrades were leading Party members, including Jim Waller, a member of the Central Committee. North Carolina's Chief Medical Examiner, Dr. Page Hudson, confirmed that all five had been "hit in the head and upper-body" (*Winston-Salem Journal*, Nov. 6, pg. 2). Yet in an eyewitness account by *Greensboro Daily News* reporter Winston Cavin says that the KKKers and Nazis "didn't really have time to aim for specific targets. They simply fired broadside into a group." (Nov. 4, 1979, pg. A4) Clearly, the assassins, using the confusion of the battle knew exactly who were Party leaders and were expert marksmen. Neither the Klan nor the Nazis have this combination of knowledge and ability—but the government does.

Were The Real Assassins Caught?

The latest arrest of Nazi-Klansmen is a cover-up for a government plot to murder Communist Workers Party leadership. The 12 Nazi-Klansmen arrested include some of the killers, but the pro-

fessional assassins responsible for the murder of leading Communist Workers Party members escaped. According to the *Greensboro Record* (Nov. 5th): "Some of the killers then carefully packed their weapons into the trunk of an auto and sped away before police arrived. A van loaded with attackers were stopped and occupants arrested." According to the *Greensboro Daily News* (Nov. 4th) "But not all the Klansmen who passed the scene were caught. Several of the lead cars apparently got away without being stopped."

In a press conference, Police Chief Swing could not explain how the white vehicle which police are still looking for was able to leave the area without being intercepted by police (*Greensboro Record*). Chief Swing stated that after the shooting erupted, which reportedly lasted for two minutes, "officers responded in less than a minute" (*Greensboro Daily News*, Nov. 4th). This is an obvious lie, the police did not respond immediately to the shooting, and several vehicles got away. Mayor Jim Melvin, however, "strongly defended the police handling of the situation," (Ibid).

Despite the fact that several cars got away, one of them a white four door sedan reportedly containing seven white males, the police claim they have most of the murderers are under arrest and are narrowing their search to a single Nazi leader. Not a word is being spoken about the several cars that sped away which includes the professional government assassins responsible for most of the murders. According to an eyewitness report, Winsten Calvin, "I saw four or five men step from an old compact sedan and aim guns at the turbulent, scuffling crowd." The arrest of Nazi-Klansmen is a cover for the escape of the government agents who targeted out leading Communist Workers Party members for assassination. □

Carter's 'Concern' Means More FBI Surveillance of Communist Workers Party

On November 5, President Carter "directed the Justice Department to activate a special unit for investigation of Klan activities around the country" reported the *New York Times* (Nov. 6, 1979). Jody Powell, the White House press secretary, was reported to have said that more than two dozen FBI agents had been sent to North Carolina to "probe the incident". But the fact is

the FBI agents weren't sent to probe the Klan. Instead, they have been sent to tail the CWP and the workers and oppressed people, burning for revenge, who support the CWP. Capitalist justice means liberty for the ruling class and slavery for the workers and oppressed. Under the cover of the Nazi-Klan, the government instigated a plot to murder 5 CWP members. After the attack, the

Greensboro police immediately arrested a CWP member and friend and charged them with inciting a riot and interfering with a police officer. Now, under the cover of investigating the Klan, Carter is sending FBI agents to tail CWP members all over the country. Government intimidation and tricks are exposing the true nature of capitalist justice to the workers, and bringing forward new waves of advanced to the Party. □

Comrade Jim Waller was an exemplary fighter and a leading member of the Communist Workers Party, U.S.A. He studied conscientiously and had a deep grasp of the Party's line. His views were penetrating, without a wasted word or phrase and were always backed up by example in his practice. Comrade Jim was profoundly self-critical and humble. He stood firmly on the correct line of the Party and fought for it with the deepest conviction. Comrade Jim was elected to the First Central Committee of the Communist Workers Party at the Party's Founding Congress.

The workers called him "Blackbeard" or "Doc". He was a folk-hero, loved and respected by the masses. After he led a strike at the Cone Granite mill, the union membership swelled from 15 to 200 in one week. The workers elected him president of the local and defended his position even after the ACTWU (Amalgamated Clothing and Textile Workers Union) collaborated with the Cone bosses to fire him. The union bureaucrats hated and feared him because of his influence among the textile workers. They were forced to push 5 locals under trusteeship in order to block the Party from being elected. At the first

National Steering Committee meeting of the TUEL (Trade Union Educational League), Jim Waller was elected the national president.

A humble pupil of the masses, he was always willing to listen and learn from the masses. At the same time, he was a teacher of the masses. As a communist fighter, he was the first to step forward in a struggle, and always put his views and principles out front. During the Party's Free the Wilmington Ten Campaign, comrade Jim did propaganda among the white workers in his mill, beating back the racist attacks from the backward workers and the KKK bosses every step of the way. His dauntless spirit and perseverance in going against the tide time and time again, his boundless humility which made him both a good pupil and a good teacher, made a lasting impression on his fellow workers and comrades who sought him out as their leader. Workers would gather around him whenever he sold the *Workers Viewpoint* newspaper at the gate.

The spirit of comrade Jim Waller will live forever. He met his death selflessly, as a class conscious communist, fully aware that his comrades and countless others will take up his post if he fell. His glorious death will only strengthen our resolve to step up the preparation for the Dictatorship of the Proletariat. □

Central Committee of Communist Workers Party Decision on Nat'l Shrine for CWP 5

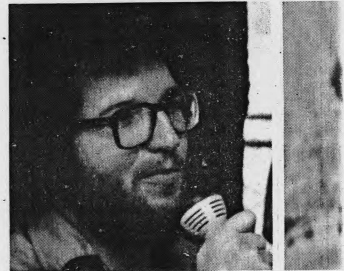

Five comrades of the Communist Workers Party died a glorious death fighting the bourgeoisie and its agents, the KKK, Nazis and the FBI. These five Bolsheviks died fearlessly charging the enemy, fully aware of the danger that faced them in the most conscious possible way, knowing that if they fell another Party member and countless others would step into their place and continue the fight. started to implement and remain to be completed. They have, in essence, asked us to continue and complete the task they have left behind. This is unmistakably their wish as their exemplary lives have shown and as movingly shown by comrade Bill's last act. Using his last breath, he said, "keep on shooting", as he handed over the handgun he was firing after he was fatally shot. Building on the Party to prepare for workers rule is the only purpose they lived for and the only wish they cherished. It remains for us to complete it. We must carry on and carry out their wish, comrades. We must carry on and take up the cause of the CWP 5.

Chairman Mao teaches, that all men must die, but death varies in its significance. To die working in the interest of the exploiting classes is lighter than a feather, and only deserves the contempt and indignation of the masses. To die working in the interests of the people is heavier than Mount Tai.

Our people, the U.S. people, have shed rivers of blood as they repeatedly

rose up spontaneously throughout history. It's the principle we live for that counts. Human beings are distinguished from animals precisely because of our consciousness. Living without principles is like living a lower form of life. Capitalism deprives them of the goal in their lives—the emancipation of the working class in order to emancipate the whole of mankind. The CWP 5 died fighting rather than live as slaves. For communists, this is the only way to live and to die. To die fighting for the working class and the noble goal of communism is the most humane and glorious way to die. Their death is merely the

last physical act in their lives. It's what they lived for that remains eternal.

For this reason, the lives of our first Party martyrs will be eternal. They will be remembered and will never die. Their lives shine out and constantly grow in us as we cherish their memory, remembering what principle they lived and fought for and how they uncompromisingly carried out the Party's line.

We deeply grieve for our comrades individually as we bid farewell to them, seeing them for the last time in our lives. But the firmer we grasp the line for which they lived and remember how they fought for the Party's line, their fighting spirit in defying all odds and fearing no sacrifice, the more they will grow in our hearts. They have not passed away. They will live on forever. Their strength too will grow millions fold, as the Party produces 3, 4 more Jims, Sandys, Bills, Cesars, Mikes and countless others to takeup their cause, cherishing their heroic deeds, walking the same path, through the replacing of their bodies with countless communist suc-

cessors and advanced elements.

The dauntless spirit of charging against automatic fire and sharpshooters' bullets, the spirit of the CWP 5 and their Party, is utterly incomprehensible to the bourgeoisie and the revisionists. This is precisely the source of the invincibility of the Communist Workers Party and the cause of proletarian revolution.

That's how we must fight in order to reach the point of no return where all turning back is impossible, until final victory.

We must take the offensive, to make the monopoly capitalist class pay for their crimes. We must make the deaths of the CWP 5 the costliest deaths the U.S. bourgeoisie ever inflicted.

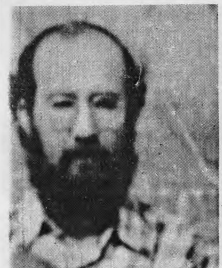

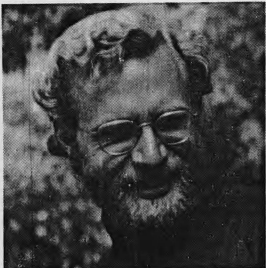

Nathans was a communist doctor his good paying job at Duke Medical work at Lincoln Community Health Center formerly a black hospital that serves He gave his time and energy selfless Party medical teams at demonstrations. He contributed what he could and carried out all the tasks asked of him. Comrade Mike was organizer for an airlift of medical supplies to Zimbabwe and helped collect over \$100,000 for the national liberation movement in Zimbabwe. The company knew they were outclassed the minute Bill opened his mouth. And the workers knew they could win. That for the first time in a long time, they had a fighting chance."

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nd understood the system was rotten ripe for revolution. It was his deep grasp of the line as well as his refusalness in carrying it out to the end that gave him the strength and consciousness to pass his gun to his fellow comrade when he was shot down. While at

Medical School at the University of Virginia, he organized health workers, and helped to form a support group for black liberation struggles in southern Africa. He was especially influenced by the anti-war movement. He dedicated his life to the working class and communism and gave up his study of medicine to work in the textile industry.

As a member of the WVO, Bill was the strongest fighter for the interests of the workers, and he became the rank and file leader in the mill. Bill was the White Oak Organizing Committee (rank and file caucus) candidate for union President. This surge of rank and file resistance under the leadership of a Communist, posed a death threat to the sellout union bureaucrats. These union hacks panicked because they knew they couldn't defeat this rank and file caucus and put all Cone locals under trusteeship. Bill was still working at the Cone White Oak mill when he was brutally murdered.

Bill's family had just lost another son to a rare form of cancer traceable to radiation poisoning received when his family lived near the Oak Ridge, Tennessee nuclear research facility. Bill's father now has the same cancer. Bill's sister-in-law is fighting for compensation from the government for the circumstances of his death.

Bill's absolute adherence to the principles of always seeking and struggling for the truth, and carrying it out to the end made him a truly outstanding class fighter. □

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vances, won lawsuits against unfair firings and used the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) to investigate the criminal safety conditions at the mill. Because the sellout union leadership failed to provide any leadership, Sandy boldly assumed communist leadership.

Sandy was a founding member of the Youth Organization of Black Unity, a national black student group. She began to read and study Marxism, was a founding member of the Revolutionary Workers League (RWL), a communist organization made up of the advanced elements of the Black Liberation Movement. When the RWL degenerated, Sandy shone out as a genuine communist. She dared to go against the tide of opportunism in the leadership of the RWL and fought for the correct line. Her daringness, her consciousness to organize, recruit and treasure the advanced to build up the Party shone through on November 3rd. While being pursued by the assassins, she gathered the kids to safety first and then came back out shooting.

Sandy joined the WVO, based on its correct line and the depth and scope of its work in the workers' day to day struggles. Sandy's boldness and dedication to the class of which she was so deeply a part, will never die. □
