The Swiss CP Calls for Banishment of Nils Andersson

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THE CHINESE and their allies FINANCE the BLUFF, LIES and THE FOUL TRICKS practiced in Switzerland by a dozen UNBALANCED, AGITATING, PROFITEERING people, CROOKS and SKUNKS, rallied around a name which they dishonor, guided by a petty adventurer who is, nevertheless, foul enough to harm the Swiss working class, with a complicity, if not the apparent support of the FEDERAL POLITICAL POLICE. The political bureau of the Swiss Communist Party demands the expulsion from our country of the Swede NILS ANDERSSON!

At a time where Switzerland expelled Italian representatives in transit, staying at a hotel, in the course of visiting friends, simply because they were Communists, at a time when our policemen sent back to their fatherland foreign workers for the simple reason of having listened to a record of an electoral speech made by a Communist representative, one is justifiably surprised at seeing that same police ignore the abject behavior of a Swede, a sad individual named Andersson, who considers himself in a conquered country and who, with a great deal of money obtained from the Chinese Communists, has the task of corrupting the workers and split the Communist and progressive Swiss movement, simply for the sake of granting those gentlemen a monopoly of moronism in Switzerland as well. Could it be that the clique which was set up in Belgium no longer answers the expectations of the Chinese so that the latter would like to intensify their demagogic propaganda in

Switzerland, always in the name of Marxism-Leninism and proletarian internationalism? Would it be that the disastrous results from the Belgian elections have opened the eyes of the people of Peking, turning them toward Switzerland. Or else, would it be, simply, that a little more rice will be taken away from the people's restaurants in China at the expense of the hungry and to the benefit of a few more pedants? Would the Chinese and the French still be the victims of the filthy farce of the Belgian clique, and how long would they remain blind to the point of distributing their petty cash surplus to gangsters residing in our country? The reason that we dare use such epithets is that we know that we can use them and not for the sake of trying to be smart.

NILS ANDERSSON MUST BE EXPULSED FROM SWISS TERRITORY IMMEDIATELY!

We demand and we will struggle for having the soil of our fatherland cleaned from that filth imported from abroad, in this case from the country of King Gustav, Sweden. Let Nils Andersson go to pasture on his own territory!

The bureau of the Swiss Communist Party is at the disposal of anyone, or any organization, wishing to obtain more details on this matter.

Nils Andersson must leave Switzerland immediately, and he will! If this first appeal to common sense is insufficient, we will adopt all necessary measures to spread the alarm among all the workers without having for this the money of the poor Chinese, but using that of the Swiss workers. Our active members are all workers and peasants, white collar workers, not afraid to honestly soil their hands. Andersson dirties his own by receiving funds, a little from everywhere, in a disgusting manner. Always, naturally, in the name of Marxism-Leninism and proletarian internationalism which he cherishes (and makes pay) so!

We thought that silence was the highest indication of scorn. Yet, sometimes, silence could be a crime or a proof of weakness. For the time being, the PST-POP, under fierce attacks by that riff-raff, is not reacting. Unless it considers them right, that party MUST react and answer. If that party deserves criticism, it should not accept them from this type people. From now on, we will no longer exchange polemics with this small handful of crazy forgers working at the pay of a few lost souls in the various Chinese embassies, including CHOU CHENG-CHOUNG, cultural attache (sic) and first secretary of the Chinese Embassy in Bern. We would like Chinese comrades

in Peking to pay greater attention when sending their representatives abroad. The latter, living in a luxurious palace with beautiful furniture may be forgetting their compatriots who still do not manage to eat a bowl of rice at every meal or have more than one pair of pants in their cupboard, if they have a cupboard. Do those muscled-up shirkers think of the fact that millions of their less spoiled compatriots are hungry? If the weather was bad and the harvest poor, would it not be better to spend the money for wheat or other comestibles instead of in bluffs and luxury or for the upkeep of their procurors? Millions of **Swiss** francs are wasted by the Chinese to maintain fraudulent individuals as those in Belgium, in Austria, in Switzerland, or elsewhere. The little Chinese gods such as Grippa (the chief for Belgium) and Andersson, the insect, for Switzerland, individuals without scruples, without scope, scornful and proud, alienated from the toiling masses through their disdain and imbecility, are paid to split the progressive classes of the countries where they operate. The Chinese comrades are disappointing their greatest friends, all revolutionaries, all **Communists**, all Marxists-Leninists, from whom they are rapidly alienating themselves.

The Swede Andersson, who lives on Chinese money on **Swiss** territory has offices belonging to a big **Swiss** insurance company, the GENEVOISE, if we are not mistaken. Money having no odor, this company lets this dangerous and predatory Swede calmly to follow his adventurous and opportunistic activities, and shuts its eyes on the various (quite various) activities taking place on its premises. It is true that the tenant Andersson boasts of having taken big insurance policies to earn the sympathy of the powerful company. In any case, it is the Chinese who pay. Therefore, their man Friday has no worry. In Belgium, his friends purchase cars and apartments out of money destined for the party. Did they do wrong? After all, as things are, why not! All these people, scorning those who work in their blue coveralls, live like prosperous bourgeois and display their satisfaction with the workers only when the latter pay their dues. It is true that the number of workers who trust them could be counted with the fingers of both hands and that not even all fingers may be necessary!

The gang of morons in Switzerland, headed by Andersson, operates, with Chinese funds, a small "newspaper" (sic) printed on a press given by the Chinese. All the articles are signed with initials only. There is the v, for example, which could very well stand for calf, cow, guttersnipe, rascal [veau, vache, voyou, vaurien] etc., or the C which, maybe, stands for idiot, ass, pig or cuckold [cretin, cul, cochon, cocu], the initial

CP, which may stand for Claire Perier or "cul-cul praline;" unless we are wrong, the initials may be those of the wife of Coulon the aristocrat who signs the articles written by her husband . . . Also found are the initials RA, which may mean adulterous rascals, or real fool or, maybe, Renee Andersson. It is a question of interpretation! This offset press is also located on the premises of the insurance company, on the first floor. It was placed there to print REVOLUTION, the luxurious publication paid for, in part, by the Chinese for the benefit of their friends. This publication having been subsequently printed, for various reasons, in Paris, Andersson had to justify his job. Thus, in order to replace the elegant and expensive, very expensive, REVOLUTION, he printed a few delirious Chinese brochures, which are probably selling as well as the many copies of the book found in bookstores, bearing Grippa's signature, who failed to find customers for his "junk." Still, paper dealers are always available, paying 3 francs per 100 kilograms for this type of funny literature. Through one of his myridons the Swede Andersson got in touch with the leaders of our party who, happily, were mistrustful from the beginning. The subject of King Gustav was already enjoying a certain repute. . . He could not mislead everyone as he had some workers, far too long. He was preparing his strike in his lair, in his lodgings at La Cite. He wanted to play the part of eminence grise in our party, receiving the necessary instructions from Grippa the unmentionable. He would have "used" us, remaining in the shadows, he the brave and valiant man. . . . Having other people assume all risks, even denouncing them, could be always useful to a certain category of ill famed individuals. At the time of our party conference, in November 1963, Andersson and his wife, a teacher at Mont-cur-Lausanne, daughter of a former or current BOURGEOIS municipal adviser of Lausanne, a professional or part time political adventuress and a teacher in her spare time, remains to be seen, proposed that our party be not called Swiss Communist Party but "movement for the preparation of a Swiss Communist Party." We objected to this idea, justifiably considering that a Trotskyite, an unbalanced person or an adventurer seeking publicity or foreign money could take over a title so dear to us: SWISS COMMUNIST PARTY.

It was Andersson who volunteered to do the first two covers of our periodical L'ETINCELLE and cut the stencils. He changed the texts, amended the subscription price, set at 6 francs, to 3 francs, forecasting difficulties, and decided, all by himself, that the first goal should be the publication of a printed newspaper. . . He was not losing track, this time, nor did he lose time. What a pitiful individual! When his acolytes, guided by him, came to ask us to commit a serious crime in connection with the theft of weapons from some arsenals, since

it has to be said and clearly shown whether we were right or wrong, he categorically refused. We were then called supporters of the POP, capitulationists, cowards, and harmless people. . . Yet, had we accepted this crazy offer, we would have not only committed FOR NOTHING, a serious crime but we would have also had our party banned and its members put in jail. It is probable that those were the "goals" of this brilliant Marxist-Leninist. Then, we had violent meetings at the premises of this gentlemen where he offered us, in writing, Grippa as a moderator. No less! It was then that the break between this scoundrel and us took place, a break which was also caused by other events, too long to relate here. To think that the Andersson couple would consider itself beaten would be to misjudge its need to make money at the expense of hungry foreign workers. We warned them to keep quiet for otherwise we would tell the truth. They refused to understand, and cast aspersions against us everywhere. We have been patient. Now, that is enough. We are denouncing them and we want to clarify the public opinion, even if this would displease the Chinese and other comrades who joyfully swallow all this bluff. We will not allow this couple to act as Jacquot Grippa acted in Belgium, i.e., mislead the Chinese in order to obtain "subsidies" amounting to hundreds of thousands of francs. These individuals, who are not even frogs, take themselves, or would like others to take them, as being as big as oxen. And this, without blinking an eye! In Belgium, for example, the sheet edited by the Grippa people is pompously called La Voix du Peuple (The Voice of the People). Yet, as was precisely said by the true Belgian revolutionaries rallied in the PROGRESSIVE WORKERS' MOVEMENT, who understood, in no time, the political farce of Grippa and his supporters, this is not a voice of the people but "a voice which is not the people's." This publication is printed in 6,000 copies, 150 of which are sold! The balance, as the tons of brochures or other printed matter published in Belgium, or imported from China, goes to the paper dealers or the public bathrooms.

In Switzerland, the small group of unbalanced people followers of the Andersson couple, is less than ten. This does not prevent those eccentrics and bad jokers from shamelessly claiming that there are several hundreds of them. . . . Naturally, this sounds better, when it is a question of getting "subsidies!"

The Chinese comrades and some of their friends trust that type individuals. That is their right. However, they are dealing a serious blow against those who had faith in them and who were their TRUE FRIENDS. When, in front of us,

the teacher Renee Andersson told her husband that if his Chinese friends suspected how bad he was to her they might be less generous with him, that was enough to make us suspicious. When this brilliant politician, daughter of a former bourgeois municipal adviser in Lausanne stated that "the cultural attache (sic) in Bern, Chou Cheng Choung had just the minimum level of intelligence required, for once, he was probably not far from the truth, since no one is able to understand the sympathy displayed by this couple of adventurers, unless he is in love with the beautiful Renee. This could be possible, having told us that Mrs. Andersson was brilliant and dynamic. . .

We would like to ask one question to this Swede: what was the part he played in the arrest, in Lyon, of an abbot, a few years ago, and why is he banned from residing in France. Another question: with what funds did he go, together with his wife, to Algeria, claiming to make an inspection on the spot, for the FLN? Did he not go simply for the sake of spending a beautiful holiday with the money taken from Algerian workers, lulling them with vile lies? A third question: how is the money taken as "monthly dues" of 30 francs, paid by a few Spanish anarchists whose "treasurer" is Renee used? Are any future holidays to Spain contemplated?

Let us now ask the federal political police a few questions. Is Andersson rendering it a few services to be allowed to peacefully reside in Switzerland? He himself boasts that he could not be expelled since he is married to a **Swiss** and that the latter should follow him, if expelled, something which is impossible since no **Swiss** citizen can be expelled! Therefore, under the pretense of a marriage, maybe even arranged for the purpose, a foreigner residing in Switzerland could act as he wishes, split the workers' class, publish writings against the authorities, the army and various institutions (leaflets which we would support, had their origin been different), and hold, in his premises, meetings where crime is discussed. Was it not after leaving such premises, after a meeting held one Saturday, that an enthusiast from this clique telephoned our comrade Bulliard at 3 A.M. asking him to resign and telling him that otherwise he would be killed? Andersson told us that the BUTO considered him as a dangerous individual and that at the beginning of the year it had expelled from Switzerland one of the printers, of French origin, employed by him, simply because he was employed there. Naturally, it is probable that Andersson wanted to appear important. The fact, however, remains: the worker is expelled and the boss, the dangerous adventurer, is left in peace. WHY?

The **Swiss** Communist Party asks for, DEMANDS the IMMEDIATE expulsion of Nils Andersson from **Swiss** territory. No time should be given to this fraud who will probably present himself as a martyr and who uses lies and bluffing imitating his friend Grippa in misleading the Chinese and some of their friends. Who has ever seen a single time the beautiful Andersson, the tough guy. . . in blue coveralls or with the calloused hands of the worker? In Switzerland we do not need foreigners who live through the support of other foreigners who deprive their own compatriots from food to generously feed a few hoodlums who split the revolutionary forces through trickery and incredible but true trickery!

Naturally, the small group following this couple draw no response from the workers. However, describing themselves as **Communists** and Marxists, these forgers also double in the role of scoundrels. Our party has nothing in common with the three or four imbeciles who have united under the title of Romand Federation of **Swiss Communists**. It does not wish to soil or dishonor itself in dealing with those few pitiful grinning monkeys who are turning out to be more dangerous to the Communist movement in Switzerland than all the bourgeois parties put together since the latter are, at least, known, and everyone knows what to expect from them.

A few of our members have given a substantial part of their wages to the party. Wishing to clear the matter up, they then suggested, if it could benefit Marxism in Switzerland, to abandon their positions, knowing that they were not infallible. To do this, they simply asked to be reimbursed for they did not wish to give money they had earned through hard work, through the sweat of their brows, to such individuals, if things were to take that turn. It is clear that it is less difficult to receive dollars from the Chinese than to live modestly on a workers' pay. These people did not answer. However, all the members who attended our meeting did not wish for our party leaders to abandon their positions. This mark of trust was the best possible encouragement to continue our struggle for truth, for the triumph of Marxism-Leninism in Switzerland, for the establishment, in our dear fatherland, of a socialist society which would establish the dictatorship of the proletariat and absolute social justice. Thus, the political procurors and pimps supported by the republic of China were eliminated once and forever. We had decided to ignore this trash; they tried to attack and we had the right to tell the truth, even if it may be displeasing to some. We will, in no case, take up this matter again. Other tasks await us.

We are always ready to unite with all the revolutionary forces of the country and we will not divide the workers affiliated with the PST-POP. This would be the opposite of the role we play. However, we call upon all the workers to unite, to organize by joining one of the two worthwhile parties in Switzerland: the **Swiss** Labor Party and the **SWISS COMMUNIST PARTY**, which, one day, will certainly unite for the good of the progressive forces of our country.
