The editors of l'Etincelle are no pen-pushers. They are all manual workers, and so they are asking their readers throughout the world to excuse their stylistic and orthographic errors.

Our bulletin receives no help from the outside. It recommends itself to persons who could help either by subscribing or by giving material support, which they may do in the form of furnishing paper and stamps.

L'Etincelle, connecting the Marxist-Leninists of Switzerland with those in the rest of the world, reflects the ideas of the majority of the leaders of the SCP (Swiss Communist Party). There is no other newspaper, no other periodical in Switzerland which could honestly call itself representative of the Marxist-Leninists.

La Voix Ouvriere, daily of the Swiss Labor Party, is a party organ supporting the Soviet comrades. On the national plane, La Voix Ouvriere reflects the same ideas that we do on several points. On the questions that divide the international Communist movement, however, we differ from that paper which, despite its errors and faults, may claim to be representing a leftist Swiss party.

Besides La Voix Ouvriere there is no organ that could honestly claim to be representing the Communists and Marxist-Leninists. But we must be on guard against a nebulous paper, one without contact with the workers, which is periodically being published in Switzerland and which is deceiving all Marxist-Leninists in the world.
