Comrade Aravindan Balakrishnan, Secretary of the Party Committee of the Workers' Institute of Marxism-Leninism-Mao Tsetung Thought, Comrade Chanda Fattai (close comrade and wife of Comrade Balakrishnan and a member of the Party Committee), Comrade Lim Poh Seng, a member of the Party Committee and two other comrades of the Communist Collective of the Mao Tsetung Memorial Centre, Comrades Martin Clarke and Nicola Clarke, were arrested on trumped-up charges by the frenzied British fascist state (an integral part of NATO, led by the U.S.) on Saturday, March 4, 1978 from the Centre, when the fascist police under the most flippant excuses tried to forcibly enter it. Our comrades, militantly defended the integrity of our organisation.

This purile attempt to restrain our comrades and intimidate our organisation comes in the context of repeated harassment and unjust detentions of the comrades of the Workers' Institute and shows the utter impotence of the British fascist state and its hoodlums in the face of the strength of the people and their concentrated representatives, the devoted pupils of beloved Chairman Mao here in Britain, the most moribund part of the imperialist heartlands!

Comrade Balakrishnan led the comrades who were arrested together with him in militantly denouncing the fascist court when they appeared in Camberwell Magistrates Court on Monday, March 6, and again on March 13, 1978, whilst upholding the revolutionary authority of our Party, the great, glorious and correct Communist Party of China and beloved Chairman Hua Kuo-feng. They shouted the slogans "Death to the 2 hegemonic superpowers, U.S. and Soviet Union!", "Death to the British fascist state!", "Long live the great, glorious and correct Communist Party of China!", "Long live beloved Chairman Hua Kuo-feng!", "Eternal glory to beloved Chairman Mao!", "Long live the INTERNATIONAL DICTATORSHIP OF THE PROLETARIAT."

Faced with the resolute denunciation by our comrades, the "magistrate", the punny puppet of the British fascist state, quickly sent our comrades to remand once again and to reappear on Tuesday, March 21, 1978. The three men comrades are remanded in Brixton Prison and the two women comrades are now in Holloway Prison.

Comrade Balakrishnan who is a former student of the London School of Economics suspended his studies in 1967 in order to take the path of integrating with the working people in the poor and oppressed working class community of Brixton and leads in the building of a revolutionary stable base area here in Brixton, especially since 1974 so as to build the NEW WORLD of socialism and communism.

The work of the Women's Commission of the Workers' Institute is led by Comrade Balakrishnan, the Party Secretary. Comrade Chanda who is being trained by him in particularity is the Secretary of the Commission.

Our two leading comrades are mobilising the working people and the student youth and intellectuals with the Proletarian Revolutionary Line of Chairman Mao since the early 1960s in Britain and have as such sustained repeated attacks by the British fascist state. This is the sixth time that Comrade Balakrishnan has been put in political detention by the British fascist state and its fascist court system. But each time, inspired by the revolutionary tradition of the people of the world, in particular, that of the international proletariat, our comrades have plunged into revolutionary work with even greater vigour and dedication, fully convinced that victory always belongs to us!
