UPHOLD PROLETARIAN INTERNATIONALISM!

October 1st, 1949, saw the birth of the great People's Republic of China led by the Communist Party of China and beloved Chairman Mao. The dictatorship of the proletariat in China from that day began to take measures internally and externally in order to unite as one with the international revolutionary forces. As Chairman Mao clearly stated: "This is our formula, our principal experience, our main programme". (On the People's Democratic Dictatorship, 1949). A New China to build a New World was the orientation. In the past 30 years every effort has been made by our glorious Party, applying invincible Mao Zedong Thought, to do just that. No distortion by the media of the old bourgeoisie of Europe and North America or the new bourgeoisie of the Soviet type can cover up the magnificient contributions of Socialist China in the world today. People all over the world are now irresistibly rallying around it as mankind's standard-bearer in the march towards a bright future.

Summing up the historical experience of the international communist movement and in particular, the experience of the first socialist state, the Soviet Union, and of its degeneration into revisionism and social-imperialism, Chairman Mao put forward his famous theory of continued revolution under proletarian dictatorship. Affirming that socialism can be built in one country but that communism can be built only on a world scale, this theory has provided the guidance to transform the dictatorship of the proletariat in China from a national into an international one. In 1977, following the defeat of the gang of four in China, the INTERNATIONAL DICTATORSHIP CF THE PROLETARIAT has been established under the leadership of our Party and beloved Chairman Hua, the brilliant successor of Chairman Mao. Using covert forms and waging electronic and satellite warfare, Socialist China is today engaged in dismantling the old world propped up by the two "superpowers", the United States and the Soviet Union and reorganising the world at every front so that the people of the world are truly the masters of this world.

The Party Committee of the Workers' Institute is launching this meeting and film show on the theme "Socialist China Builds the New World -- Political Aspects" as the first of a three-part series to inform progressive people about the unprecedented and excellent stage the world is in. The other parts, to be held in the same venue at the same time, deal with economic aspects (Nov. 9) and scientific and cultural aspects (Nov. 23). All are welcome!

FILM SHOWS

SUN SHINES OVER LHASA: This is a 35-minute documentary film of socialist construction in Tibet. It includes historical excerpts. The film is in English and in colour.

TANZAM RAILWAY: This 45-minute colour film in English is a moving tribute to Socialist China's proletarian internationalist aid to the countries of the Third World. Popularly known as "Freedom Railway" this 1,900 kilometre railway links the two African countries of Tanzania and Zambia. 14,000 Chinese workers united as one with 40,000 African brothers to complete it in record time.
