-- 48-minute colour film in English.

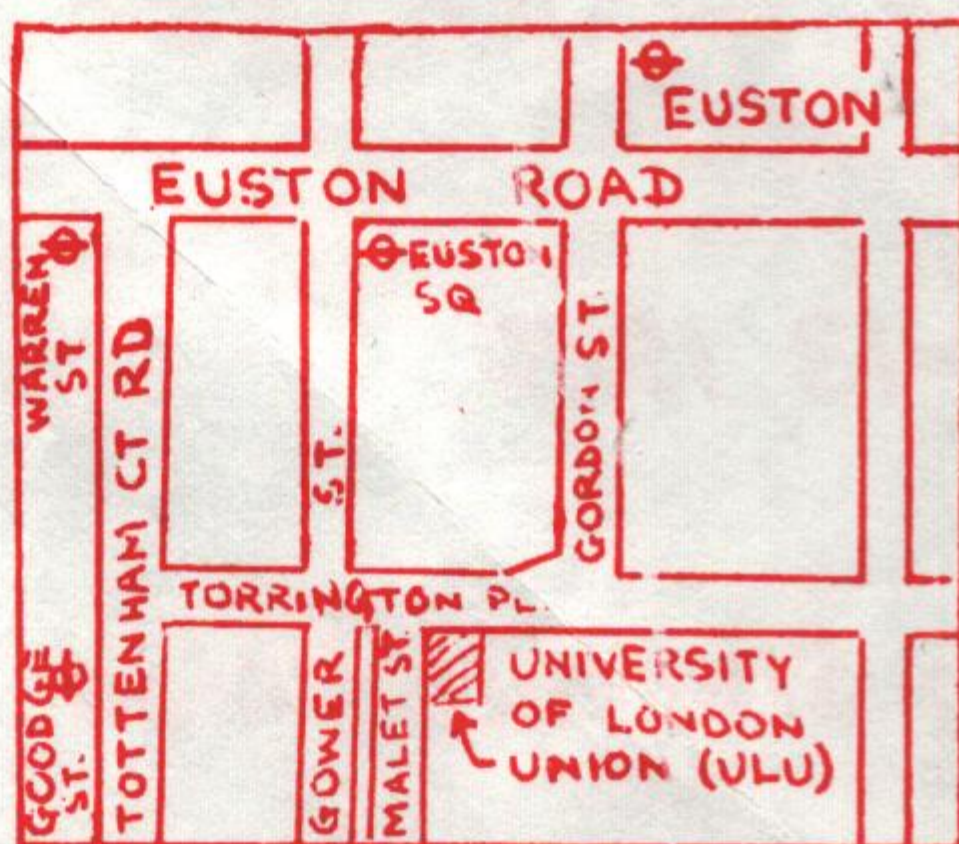
