## TO ALL FACTION COORDINATORS

Dear Comrades,

At a national meeting of the YSA Majority Faction held in New York City on July 5, 1974, we decided to maintain the faction at least until the Oberlin educational conference. This will allow us time to evaluate the split of the Internationalist Tendency party. At Oberlin, we will decide whether or not the faction should continue to exist.

Thus it is very important that local factions continue to regularly collect and send in faction dues. When we formed the faction, we pointed out that it would have to be self-financing -- that is, each member would have to make regular financial contributions. We need these funds to pay for faction mailings and the special June faction tours.

We have suggested that faction members contribute \$.50 a week. In June, we received \$159 in dues, but a number of areas have not yet sent in their June pledges. In addition, it is important that faction contributions for July and August should be collected and sent in as quickly as possible. Currently the Majority Faction has debts of over \$1,300.00, and we must make every effort to liquidate these debts in the immediate future.

To facilitate the collection of faction dues, it would be valuable if faction coordinators and treasurers: 1) urge all Faction Members to contribute a weekly pledge (\$.50 per week or more if possible); 2) collect and send in dues each week; and 3) inform the faction center of the area's total faction pledge and the individual amounts.
