#### TO ALL MAJORITY FACTION NC MEMBERS AND COORDINATORS

Dear Comrades,

At a national meeting held during the week of the Socialist Activists and Educational Conference last month, the YSA Majority Faction was dissolved. Enclosed are minutes of that meeting and the two other national meetings held by the Majority Faction.

The Majority Faction was formed last May in response to a serious challenge by members of the Internationalist Tendency to the YSA's longstanding democratic centralist norms. In July, the YSA National Executive Committee, after reviewing the findings of the SWP Control Commission, voted to recognize the split of the Internationalist Tendency Party from the YSA. Since that time, it has become clear that our democratic-centralist norms no longer face a serious internal challenge. It was on this basis that the decision to dissolve the Majority Faction was nade.

The Majority Faction incurred substantial expenses in the course of conducting a national tour of YSA locals in June and for Majority Faction mailings. The income from Majority Faction members dues received to date does not cover these expenses, therefore the faction is currently in debt. A number of local faction caucuses owe back dues that could help in our effort to wipe out these debts. Coordinators should make a serious effort in the coming week to collect back dues through August. Dues should be sent to New York as soon as possible.
