In the past few days the Healyites have been distributing copies of a <u>Bulletin</u> supplement entitled "Sylvia Franklin--G.P.<u>U. Agent Unmasked."</u> What is of immediate concern to the party is the increased danger of provocations by the Healyites outside forums, branch meetings, summer schools, or other events.

The <u>Bulletin</u> supplement ends on the following ominous note: "The completion of the Sylvia Franklin case is a milestone in the two-year inquiry, but there is much more to come. We have reason to believe that this could well produce provocations against our movement all over the world."

This "prediction" of violence can only be read as a statement of their intentions. In fact, the following issue of the <u>Bulletin</u>, falsely states that "provocations were attempted against the <u>Bulletin</u> salesmen" as they were distributing the supplement outside two party branches.

Obviously, we want to try to prevent any incident in which the Healyites could succeed in provoking comrades into shoving matches or the exchange of blows.

Comrades should be made aware of the latest stage in the Healyites' slander campaign, and reminded of the importance of not allowing themselves to be provoked.
