Dear Jack,

Here is a report on the Militant-France campaign here.

**MILITANT SALES:** By the end of the YSA meeting Wednesday night there was only 50 Militants left of the 2,000 we received Monday. The rest were sold or comrades took them to sell (they took them without any quotas being assigned). All the comrades have sold or have made plans to sell. Those planning to sell after Wednesday had none left to sell by then. Here is what we sold: Monday - 285; Tues - 585; Wed - 520; Thurs - 191; Fri - 148. (Thurs was Mem. day; we had a picnic)

Our charts show that two comrades sold over 200 each (highest sales by Dave, 16 year old high school student, joined 2 weeks ago was mad because he didn't find out about the campaign till Wed night!) Seven comrades sold over 100 each; 14 sold over 50 each.

We sold approximately 1,400 to the campus community, 200 at shopping centers, 150 in bookstores, 80 at Shell Development Co., 75 at Cal State Hayward, 50 at Merritt College. Comrades report brisk sales at shopping centers: 80 in two hours at COOP, 30 in 1/2 hr. at Safeway, 50 in 45 minutes at Mayfair. We had plans to go to many other places, but ran out of papers.

**BOOKSTORE** - You probably received the picture of the banner on the front of the bookstore "SOLIDARITY WITH THE WORKERS AND STUDENTS OF FRANCE." We also have a "News Window" with good clippings for passers-by to read. We give a free Militant with purchases of \$1. or more. We give 10% off any sale with a purchase of the Militant-YS sub. A sign says subscription free to active GIs.

**FUND RAISING FOR FRENCH STUDENTS:** We made red banners 24x36 inches to sell; profits will go to JCR. We have cans in five bookstores -- they are decorated with pictures of the barricades, etc. and say "support the French students." I think we have about \$10. already from the cans.

**ARTICLES AND LEAFLETS** - We had articles on our activities and on the meaning of the events in France in both the Barb and the Daily Cal. We wrote a leaflet to workers that we will distribute Monday. I am writing a challenge to the CF to debate the issues in France -- will go in the Barb, maybe others.

We are planning a solidarity rally Tuesday - see leaflet.

We will have two public meetings June 9 and 16 on France. We had a forum last Friday. We are organizing an internal class series on France to begin June 16.
