TO ALL SWP MEMBERS

Dear Comrades,

At its March 23 meeting the Political Committee decided to open the party internal bulletin to written contributions from party members on the international issues in dispute in the world movement. The opening of this literary discussion on the international issues had been previously authorized by the National Committee.

At a later date the Convention Call will open the party internal bulletin to contributions on all the other questions before the party convention in addition to the disputed international questions.

The opening of this literary discussion on disputed international issues does not open the oral preconvention discussion in the branches. The date for the opening of the oral discussion in the branches will be set by the Convention Call which will be issued by the National Committee at its plenary meeting April 29.

Contributions to the literary discussion on the world movement should be submitted in typed, triple-spaced format to the national office and should include title, author, and author's branch. Contributions should be typed 60 characters or less to a line to facilitate type-setting for the bulletin.
