
## UNITE AND SERVICE OF THE SERVICE OF

Last autumn saw a great victory for unilateralism when the Labour Party passed by a massive 2/3rds majority 'Composite 51'.

This declared 'an unequivocal and unambiguous commitment to unilaterally remove all nuclear weapons and all U.S. bases from Britain' in addition to No Cruise and No Trident!



Back in 1960 the Labour Party had a unilateralist position, but the right wing of the party were able to overturn this decision easily the following year.

The right wing leaders went on to initiate secret nuclear weapon deals of which even their Labour government colleages were unaware.

These same forces in the Labour movement are just as bitterly opposed to C.N.D. and unilateralism as ever, but are not able to win a straight reversal of policy as easily as they could in 1961. Thus the 'fudging'.

Labour's election campaign document has been previewed in the 'Guardian' which comments "the draft weaves the strands of multilateralism and unilateralism together into a single argument".

But multilateralism is DESIGNED TO FAIL and merely provides a cynical cover up for the even greater stockpiling and develop -ment of weapons. Attempts to 'interweave' and confuse this with real unilateral disarmament are just attempts at a creeping reversal of Labour's conference policies.
