Ernest Mandel (1923-1995)

Ernest Mandel was among the most creative and original Marxist thinkers of the 20th century. His death on July 20th of this year ended a lifetime of revolutionary activity which began in the resistance to the Nazi occupation of his native Belgium and continued for 50 years in his role as a central leader of the Fourth International (FI) - the worldwide organisation of revolutionary socialists founded by Leon Trotsky and others in 1938. Mandel epitomised the anti-Capitalist and anti-Stalinist traditions of the FI.

As part of a series of international commemorations of Mandel's life and thought, *Socialist Outlook* is organising this rally to celebrate his contributions.

The following day, an International Symposium is being held to discuss Mandel's legacy as activist, theoretician and revolutionary leader.
