The greatest appeal that Moscow made to the artists, was the erection of large number of temporary memorials in the streets, and squares. One must admit frankly that this effort was a complete failure. Artists of various tendencies, part icularly the left, put up some repulsive creations many of them to be taken down again with the utmost speed. It is doubtful if even a single one could be recognised as a work of art.

One must admit however, that this attempt only ended in failure in Moscow. Not so in Petrograd. There, there were few bad ones, a few unacceptable ones but there were also some excelent memorials. Everybody will deplore the destr-
