

COMMUNIST INT'L EXECUTIVE RAPS THE OPPOSITION

Tasks of British Party Are Outlined

MOSCOW, Feb. 20.—A resolution regarding the tasks of the British Communist Party was unanimously adopted by the Plenum of the Executive Committee of the Communist International Saturday. The resolution was introduced by the British Commission.

The plenum also adopted Thaelmann's resolution on the question of the Trotskyist opposition. The Plenum entirely agreed with the measures taken by the Communist Party of the Soviet Union against the Trotskyist opposition, emphasizing the fact that the latter was rallying itself around the worst opportunist elements and renegades in the Communist movement.

In view of the counter-revolutionary attitude of the Trotskyist opposition and its hostility to the Soviet Union, the Plenum entirely approved of the measures taken by the Communist Party of the Soviet Union.

The Plenum declared that the Trotskyist opposition must also be strongly fought in other countries.
