Dear Mr. Carter:

I am in receipt of a mimeographed cablegram issued by the State Department directed to the "Secretary of State" from "Young" at Riga, bearing date of September 25, 1920. It reads as follows:

"New Executive committee third international on August 10th [1920] decided that the communistic party and the *<illeg.> party* be single party on basis decided *as* second congress of third international and that this unification must be effected no later than October 10th next, those not abiding by this decision to be excluded from third international."

Apparently there is some error in the cablegram, as I can not make out the meaning of the same. I would appreciate it if you could enlighten me upon the contents of the original cablegram.
