the significance of its adoption of the materialist conception of history is that it repudiates the old and exploded idea that great men, individuals, through the power of their personality, cause all social changes and political revolutions.

In like manner the old nursery tales of how George Washington freed the country and Abraham Lincoln freed the black slaves have been laid on the shelf so far as people of intelligence are concerned, for they know that the causes back of the American revolution, and back of negro emancipation were fundamentally economic.

When the capitalist system began to operate in this country it had not only its own development before it, but had all the uncivilized and uncaptivated world as a market, with nothing but the old countries as competitors for that trade.

One immediate means of using up the surplus would be a great war. This would have the effect of restoring prosperity of the capitalist kind, and also serve as a means by which American capitalists could contest with the capitalists of other nations for certain foreign markets.

The final solution of the industrial problem is in Socialism, which will come soon as the working class becomes sufficiently intelligent to demand it, though the capitalists may have the pleasure of promoting a few more wars before the workers get next to the game.

Some machines are replaced before they are fully worn out, while for various reasons some machines are suffered to operate indifferently until they break down of their own weakness.

It is not unlikely that a war with Japan will be forced by the ruling class of this country, and if it is done it will be for the sole purpose of keeping busy the old system by the export of life and the system of the workingmen's product.
