We are happy to see the Jewish Branch taking hold, and we hope that soon Buffalo will not have to take a back seat even for Rochester in the Young People's movement and Socialist Schools.

The passage of the Compensation Bill marks an epoch in the Socialist movement in this country. It marks the time when the dollar aristocracy gave the first real serious sign of alarm at the oncoming wave of Socialism. With the passage of this bill the real defenders of the "vested" interests entered upon the policy inaugurated by Bismarck. Charity is giving us back a portion of what has been stolen from you by charity-organizing and making the recipients feel more than the giver. Let us clean up and do away with the necessity of charity and all these hangers will become a thing of the past.

Let us abolish the capitalist system with its exploitation by a few to the detriment of all the others, and establish in its place a civilized society, organized and managed for the benefit of all.

We wonder if the new office of Commissioner of Charities will have time to take up matters pertaining to that work. If it is as efficient as the Board of Health we might as well abolish the office now.
