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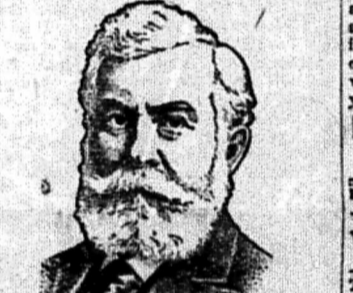

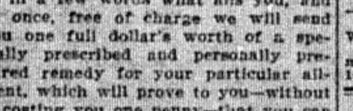

Los Angeles Magnates Wage War on Organized Labor; Help Asked

makers, structural iron workers, and their respective helpers sent a very respectful letter to the Foundrymen's Association, asking for a conference to consider an increase in wages and the reduction of hours for the men engaged in this particular industry.

Their communication was dealt with contemptuously, and upon receiving no reply a strike was declared June 1. Upon the first call every union man responded. It must be borne in mind, however, that with all the efforts set forth to organize Los Angeles...

Right here allow me to call attention to the fact that in Los Angeles county, a city with a population of 350,000, no shopmen either in iron or wood can obtain a job directly from any firm; he is directed to the office of the Citizens' Alliance...

Should he be directed to go back to his former employer, whether he likes it or whether he don't like it, he has to choose one of two things, go back or leave town. So that you can understand that this kind of a system in vogue for years in that so-called earthly paradise...

All the other shops, however, are tied up. Ten shops employing an aggregate of 200 men have signed up with the organization and working strictly under conditions. Thirty-five of the best buildings in the course of construction have been completely tied up since the first of June...

Men who had charge of the work of construction on three different occasions permitted large beams to crash to the floor. On the Alexander Hotel two weeks ago today a large girder fell killing one non-union man outright...
