SEBEL TAKES OATH APRIL 19

Wash. April 19.—The city of Washington has today taken the oath of office under the new charter. Mayor Sebel, who was sworn in by the city clerk, took the oath in the presence of a large number of city officials and members of the press. The ceremony took place in the city hall, where the mayor read a statement in which he pledged to uphold the charter and to serve the people of the city with integrity and efficiency.

The new charter provides for a mayor and a council of seven members. The mayor is elected for a term of four years, and the council members are elected for terms of two years. The charter also provides for a city auditor and a city controller. The new charter was approved by the voters in a referendum on April 15, 1927.
