STATE REFERENDUM NO. 13, 1919. THE ADOPTION OF AN AMENDMENT TO THE STATE PARTY CONSTITUTION PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF STATE PARTY DUES.

Notice initiated by Local Oklahoma City and seconded by fifteen other locals. Submitted to referendum of the membership on Nov. 10th. Vote taken on Nov. 20th. Votes received after that date will not be counted.

NOTICE.
 Back on Section 5 of the present state constitution and amended following as Section 5.
 Each local shall pay in advance for national and state dues the amount of \$1.00 for each year to cover the period from January 1st to June 30th of each year, and further one dollar to cover the period from July 1st to December 31st of each year.

These dues shall in all cases be paid before January 1st and July 1st for the period following; provided that the dues of any member may be paid for two periods in advance.

Shall the Amendment be Adopted

The individual member will vote "Yes" or "No," according as he or she believes in the proposed amendment, and after tearing off the coupon along the perforated line will deliver both the ballot and the detached coupon to the local secretary not later than Nov. 26th.

The local secretary will compile the vote of his local and report the same on one of these ballots. Mark the total number of votes cast by your local members for and against the amendment, and the square of the total of the "Yes" and "No," and sign the attached coupon as local secretary, and send to the state office along with the signed coupons which have been detached from all the ballots which were voted.

Enclose the report and the signed coupon, AND NOTHING ELSE, in an envelope addressed to the State Executive Committee, 1225 Indiana Building, Oklahoma City, Okla., and so that it will be sent to time to reach the state office not later than November 30th.

Oklahoma to Remain in the Hands of the Democrats and Crafters Four More Years. Indications Are That Socialists Have Cause to Rejoice, and Campaign of 1912 is in Full Swing

With the returns still in the hands of the democratic election crowd, little definite information of the results of last Tuesday's election in this state can be given. Indications are, however, that the official returns will show the election of democratic party officials throughout, three democratic and two republican congressmen, with about twenty republican county clerks and the balance democratic.

The Socialist vote throughout the state will show a steady and substantial gain over that of 1916. It may be mentioned in different parts of the state the Socialist lead in the republican party in party politics, and is certain likewise in the republican party. It is evident that minor of the Socialist vote has been obtained. The year of 1916 was agreed of 22,626. Conversely, the present returns show that we need of 30,000 in the present election, making a net increase of 7,374 in 10 to 12 years. This increase sufficient in itself to justify the prediction that the Socialist vote will continue to grow in the public imagination, but the results will be sufficient to give every Socialist in the state renewed hope and encouragement. The Socialist campaign never ends, and no sooner was the polls closed last Tuesday than the campaign of 1912 was inaugurated. Two more years of political dishonesty and democratic misrule will be sufficient to thoroughly disgust the many thousands voters who were won over two opinions this time, but who were persuaded in the last hours of the campaign to give the demagogue brigade one more trial.

From various indications that naturally there has been the greatest progress against plutocracy and "trust" republicanism the nation has made in the past few years, and as a result the next national campaign will be the most important in the history of the republic, the thing all old parties have always stood for, and by the time the state returns have reported the great masses of the people will be looking for a change to the Socialist party.

Noting that an absolute victory could be more encouraging to the masses than any other result, and in view of demagogic and republican rearguard. Two years ago the Socialist party in Oklahoma was the most staid that they offer, all stand for the republic, the thing all old parties have always stood for, and by the time the state returns have reported the great masses of the people will be looking for a change to the Socialist party.

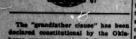
