tor in one of the best towns in the state, who spends a lot of money
continually on small personal pleasures, and yet it never dawns ove
him that he has any responsibility towards helping on the movement with which he claims to be allied. with which he claims to be allied.
One man who was a candidate for sheriff in the state last year spent 81,500 in his campaign in ways that
were utterly profitless. Think the showing the state could have made with such a fund, or even a
tenth of it. One woman told me last fall that if I would stop a week
