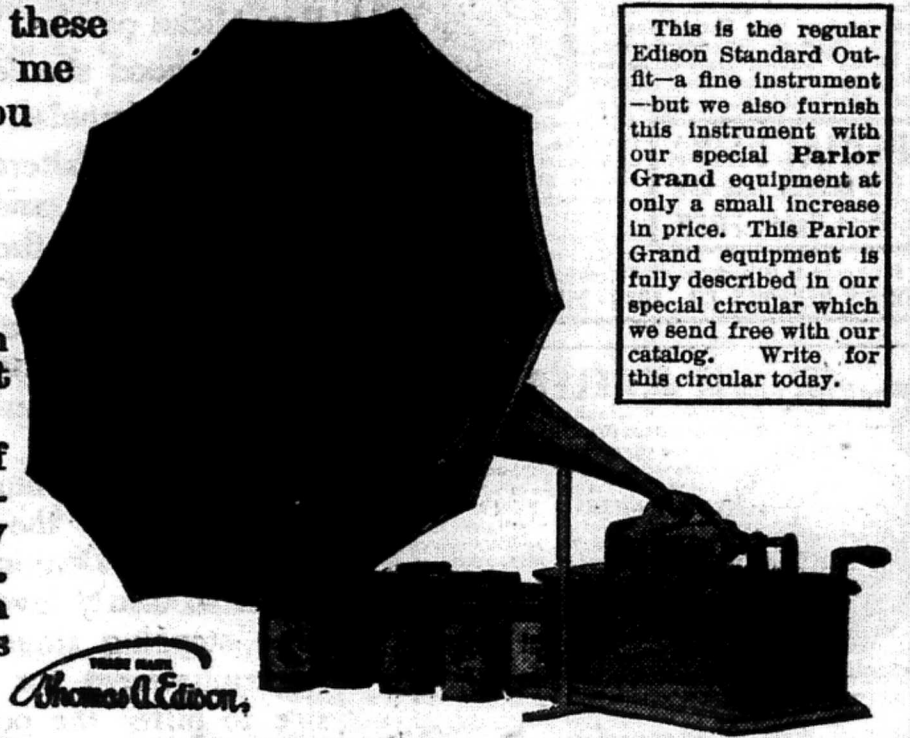

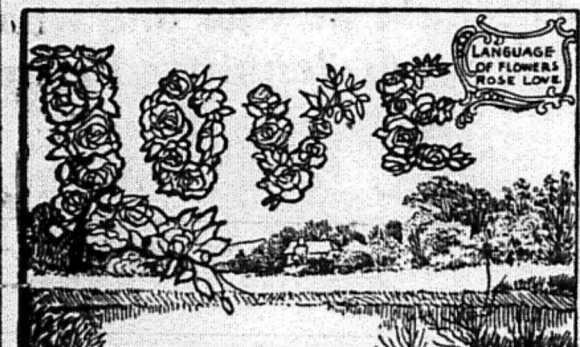
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POOR OLD GOD

Of course you do, and so do I, and so does everybody else, and when a poor cuss who is out of work strolls into the streets of our big cities he is "pinched" by the police department, and given hours to leave the city, or else is fined and placed on the rock pile, and given the poorest class of food imaginable, and consigned to a cold and desolate cell, where he spends his nights until the majesty of the law has been vindicated.

This poor devil, who has been so ruthlessly handled by the law, may have strolled from city to city, seeking work, but finding none, and being hungry, he may have stolen something.—He was willing to work when the shops closed down but was told by his **IDLE BOSS** that he was needed no longer; he was an honest man then; had a loving wife and loving children, but his **IDLE BOSS** had filled his store houses with goods, made by this man, whom we now call a **VAGRANT**, and his associates, and when he went from shop to shop he found that all of the **IDLE BOSS-ES** who owned all of the shops were doing just as his **IDLE BOSS** was doing, and the shops were all closed down, and this poor, miserable mortal, whom the law calls a **VAGRANT**, struck out across the country to find work; but everywhere he went the shops were all closed; there was a panic in the

country.—His clothes became "seedy," his shoes worn out, his hair and beard unkempt, and all on the account of him being forced by his **IDLE BOSS** to wander from home to look for work, so that he might be able to support his wife and babies.

When poverty had laid her cold and clammy hands upon him and reduced him to a beggar, then he was, in the eyes of the law, a **VAGRANT**, and treated as such, all on the account of him being an individual **WHO STROLLED FROM PLACE TO PLACE**; but when the **IDLE BOSS, WHO STROLLS FROM PLACE TO PLACE**, and who does his strolling upon the money which this poverty stricken "vagrant" and his brothers created, **BUT DID NOT GET**, struts into the same town where that "vagrant," who would work, if he had the work, is breaking rock, fashionable society wines and dines him, and makes of him a hero, while they curl their lips in scorn at the **POOR VAGRANT**, whom this **RICH VAGRANT** created.

When this rich and perfumed **IDLE WANDERER** glides into

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town in his elegant automobile, the keys of the city are turned over to him; but when this POOR IDLE WANDERER comes into town upon a blind baggage or in a cattle car, he is met by the police and escorted to jail for being idle, because he can't help it, and because his boss won't let him work.

This journal can see no difference between a rich vagrant and a poor one, if the word vagrancy means what Webster's International Dictionary says it does, as a vagrant who strolls from place to place, no matter whether he be clothed in rags or wears fashionable and tailor-made clothes, is a vagrant, just the same; and the vagrant who is dressed in the height of fashion is the one who should suffer the most, as the one who lives off of the strong arm of others is the man who should have the law meted out to him in the most severe manner.

The millionaire class do no work; they produce nothing by their own hands, but live ENTIRELY upon the efforts of others; but when their store-houses are full of goods, and when they need no longer the services of their SLAVES, they dismiss them without warning, and turn them out upon the cold charity of the world, and when their slaves become ragged, hungry and unkempt, they are run in by the police officials of our cities, and are branded as criminals, while those who have heaped poverty upon them and their families STROLL FROM PLACE TO PLACE, and are received into what we are taught to call the best homes, and wear the finest raiment that their SLAVES WEAVE, and eat the choicest food that THEIR SLAVES CREATE, and are waited upon by the sons and daughters of old, worn-out SLAVES.

We punish the working vagrant when he is compelled to be idle, but the rich vagrant we send to the United States Senate to make and execute our laws.—We punish the poor vagrant who has no settled habitation because the rich vagrant has dispossessed him.—We punish the poor, idle wanderer who has become idle, not from choice, but because the rich idler has forced him into idleness.—We condemn the sturdy beggar and send him to the rock pile because the rich have robbed him, and they do not have to beg.

By our laws of inequality we create incorrigible poor rogues, while the incorrigible rich rogues we send to our state legislatures, or to the United States Congress.

Now, Mr. Reader, if the ones who STROLL FROM PLACE TO PLACE, if the ones who have NO SETTLED HABITATION,

if an idle wanderer, if a sturdy beggar, if an incorrigible rogue is a "VAGRANT," then why should not those who do all of those things with millions in their possession, be the ones who should receive the greatest punishment, and especially when they have caused the poor, miserable and homeless to become STROLLERS FROM PLACE TO PLACE, WITH NO SETTLED HABITATION, on the account of the lack of work which has been denied them by the RICH VAGRANTS of America, who control the work which the POOR VAGRANTS must have or starve?—But you damned, limber-necked, wide-mouthed, idiotic voters teach your children to stone, ridicule and spit upon the poor vagrant, whose vagrancy has been thrust upon him by the IDLE RICH VAGRANTS, and fall down and worship at the feet of the rich vagrant who has made of the working class, vagrants for the perfumed and idle rich.—Boys, will you never learn the lesson which you must learn before you will ever be FREE?

LINCOLN'S WARNING

In 1856 Abraham Lincoln, a man whom the Republican party considers, or at least claims to consider its God, made the following prediction:

LABOR IS PRIOR TO AND INDEPENDENT OF CAPITAL. CAPITAL IS ONLY THE FRUIT OF LABOR, AND COULD NOT HAVE EXISTED IF LABOR HAD NOT FIRST EXISTED. LABOR IS THE SUPERIOR OF CAPITAL, AND DESERVES MUCH THE HIGHER CONSIDERATION. I BID THE LABORING PEOPLE BEWARE OF SURRENDERING THE POWER WHICH THEY POSSESS, and which, if surrendered, will surely be used to shut the door of advancement for such as they, and fix new disabilities and burdens upon them until all of liberty shall be lost.

"In the early days of our race the

Almighty said to the first of mankind, 'In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread,' and since then, if we except the light and air of heaven, no good thing has been or can be enjoyed by us without first having cost labor. 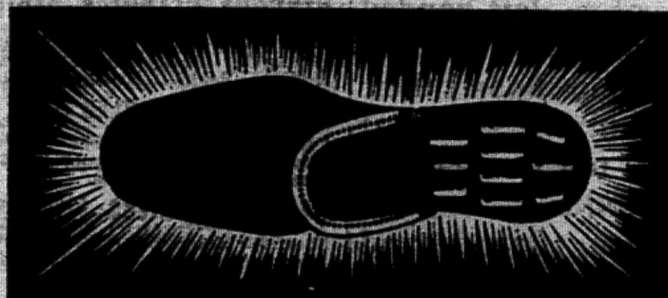
