You will see from this declaration of Mr. Draper's that it leads directly into the camp of European bondage, and into human slavery, as he virtually declares that those who were born into slavery should remain slaves, and those who were born into office should remain in office. It is a bold, arrogant, and awful bid for the establishment of kings, queens, empresses, dukes and lords in America, which our forefathers so gallantly fought against in the days of Revolutionary fame.

I cannot say positively, but I will bet my head against a rootball made of bull hide, that this man, Andrew S. Draper, bitterly opposes and denounces Socialism; as no man who believes in human rights, and believes that all men should strive for better things, could possibly have made the declaration that Draper made before the teachers of the New York University Summer School; and if American manhood does not rebel, AND DO IT QUICKLY, against the silent encroachment of the principles of European monarchs, we will, within a few decades, find ourselves hedged about with the same conditions that prompted our forefathers to leave Europe and flee to America for ref-
