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


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Colonel Maple's Illness.

that the railways need not confine railway will have no interest, "direct themselves to their primary business of carriers, but may become shippers as well. Not in so many words, but to that effect.

"The Hepburn law says that the railways must not, as carriers, transport commodities owned by themselves, or in which they have any interest, direct or indirect.

"The Supreme Court says that this does not permit them to be carrier of goods manufactured or dealt in by themselves in theory, but only in fact. They may own all the stock in a corporation which makes or deals in the goods, and while no one else has any interest in the commodities, the railways have none direct or indirect.

"The man who owns all the stock in a mine thinks he has a rather definite and direct interest in the coal or ore taken from it; but the Supreme Court says 'No.' The mining company is

legally a different person from the man telephone call of 26 Broadway, by in who owns all the stock in it.

"When the railway itself becomes a shipper, it becomes necessary for the other shippers of the same commodity to get off the earth. No matter what the law may be, the railway will give itself a better deal in transportation than it will give its competitors. No regulation possible to conceive of can place the shipper who has no railway, and who must use his competitor's line on an equality with the combined shipper and carrier. It is this portentious fact that caused the commodities clause to be incorporated in the Hepburn law. It was recognized as a fortrese for the individual business man against the conquering march over all the field of industry and commerce of the colossal combinations of mining companies, eli companies, steel companies, smelting companies, packing companies, sugar refining companies, lumber companies, steamship companies, express companies, agricultural machinery companies, banks and trust companies and the like, with the railways which are owned in large measure, and completely controlled by the same men.

"It was a puny safeguard. The problem presented was not even a hard nut for the trusts to crack. When it fell open in the Supreme Court, the other day, that great tribunal impartially gave the kernel to the trusts. and handed the shell to the people.

"That it is only a shell, is shown by the acknowledged fact that the only railway affected by it is the Delaware, Lackawanna & Western, a company which has been earning such huge returns through its coal-mining operations that its accumulations of cash are so large that it is unwilling to pay them out in dividends for fear that public opinion will revolt against its inordinate earnings-or "takings." And all the D. L. & W. has to do under the decision in the commodities case, is to form a corporation to carry on its coal trade, issue the stock in it to itself or its stockholders, pay out this embarrassing surplus as dividends on the new stock, and go on as before. 

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
