The capitalist class fears the Socialist party and represents its red flag as a flag of anarchy. It is one of their cheap political tricks to get the ignorant to come to their support, not of their country, but to their country's betrayers and exploiters.

THAT THE SOCIALIST FLAG IS RED INSTEAD OF YELLOW OR BLUE OR GREEN DOES NOT ANNOY OR ALARM INTELLIGENT PEOPLE. THEY CHOSE THE COLOR RED FOR THEIR EMBLEM NOT TO SIGNIFY THAT THEY FAVORED VIOLENCE OR THE SHEDDING OF BLOOD AS THE UNINTELLIGENT SUPPOSE AND AS ACTIONS OF THOSE IN OFFICIAL AUTHORITY OFTEN LEAD PEOPLE TO BELIEVE, BUT FOR THE PURPOSE OF TYPIFYING THE COMMON BROTHERHOOD OF ALL MEN OF ALL NATIONS THROUGH THE VEINS OF ALL AND TO THE END THAT ALL WAR AND VIOLENCE SHALL CEASE.
