FEDERATION OF CO-OPERATIVES. In England the co-operatives are forming federations to buy their goods cheaper, or even to manufacture them.

In December, 1888 it numbered 1,115, 158 co-operatives. In September, 1899, the number of its employees was 10,076.

The federation of Glasgow, founded in 1868, had reached in 1898 a figure of \$25,000,000 in sales, and employed, in 1899, 5,203 laborers and clerks.
