for freedom and unity in their land.

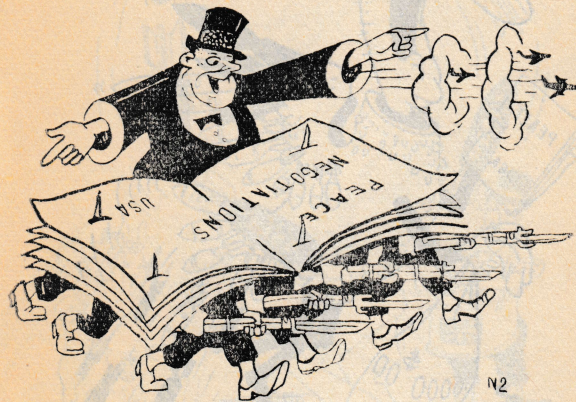
At present, the more the American government

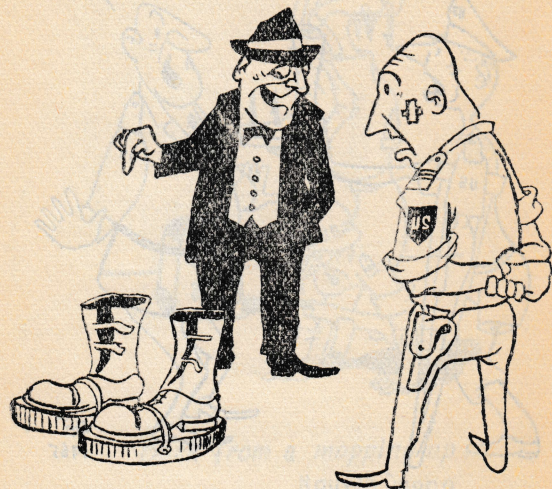

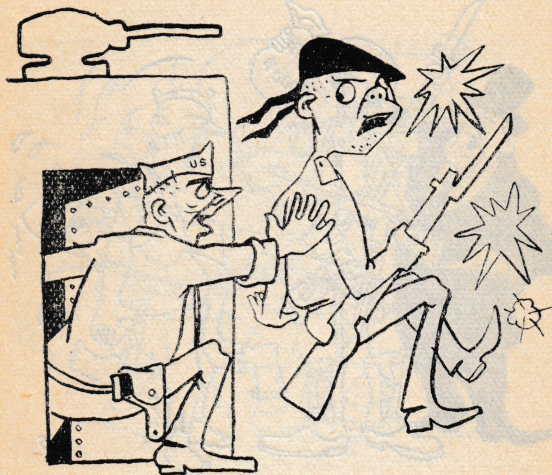

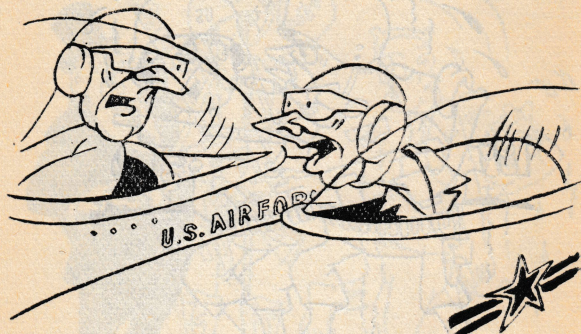

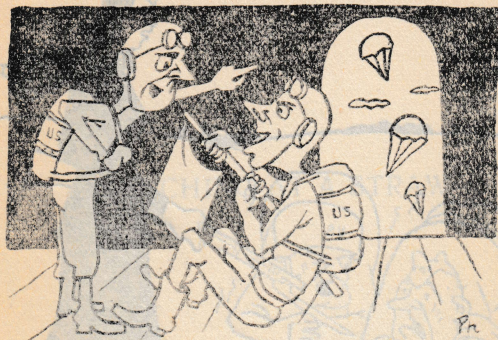

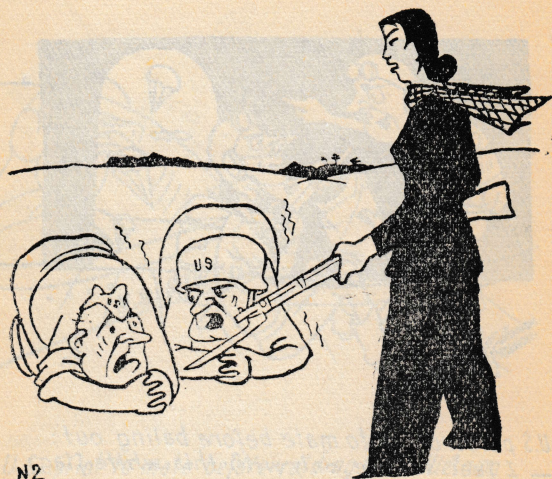

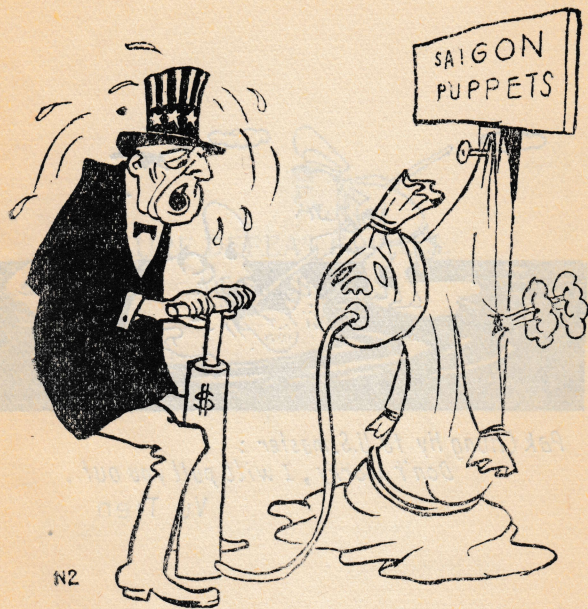

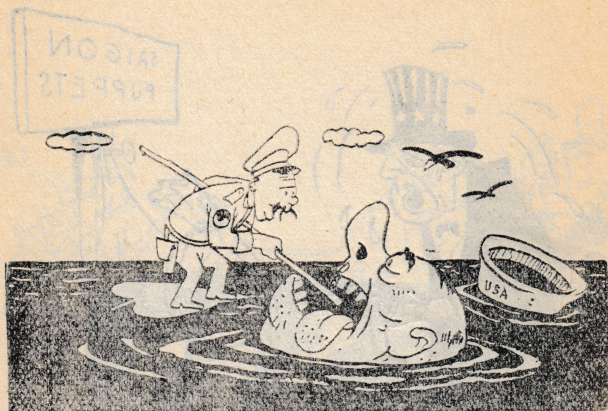

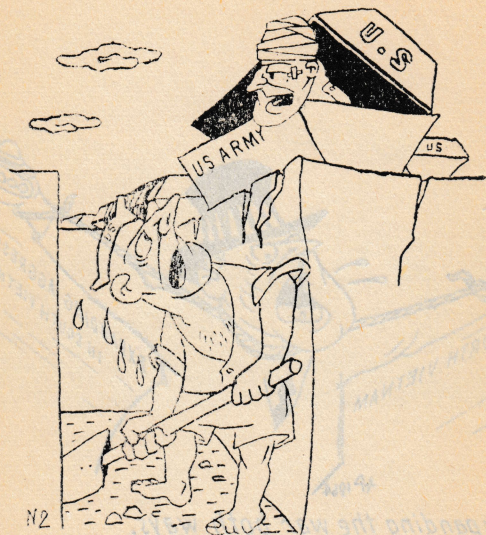

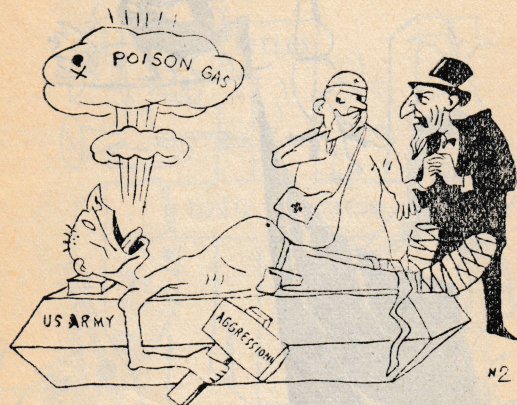

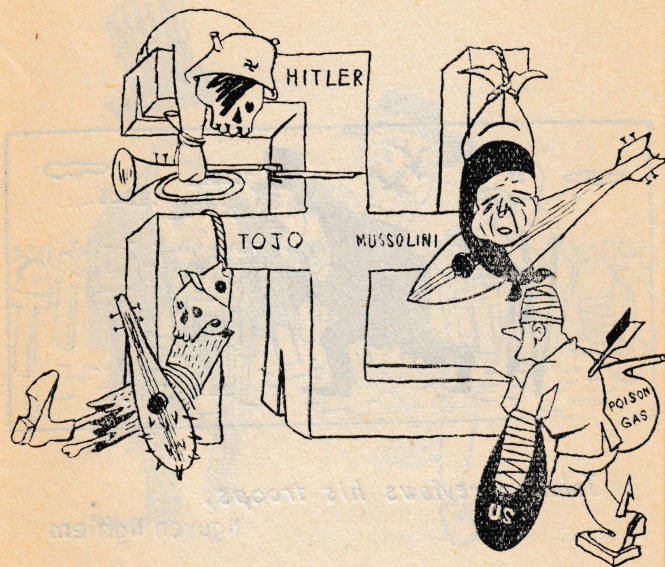

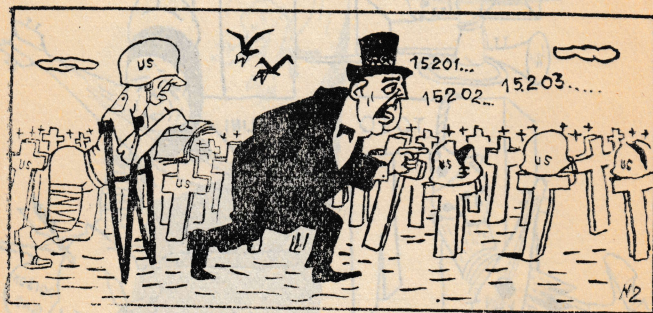

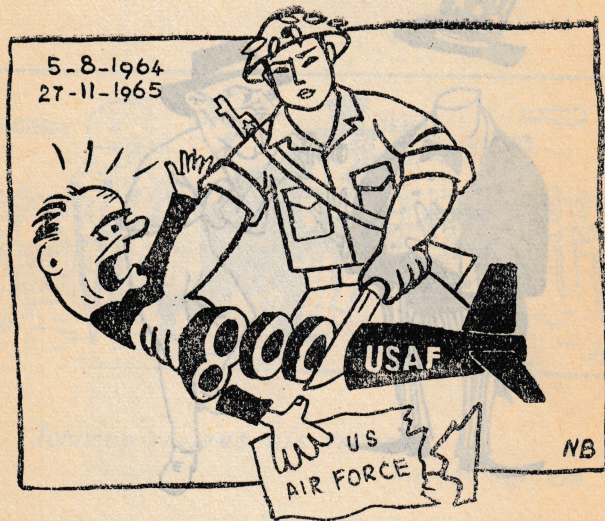

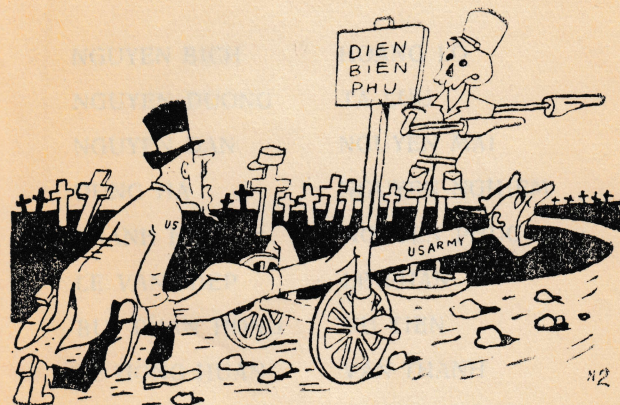
