

Herndon Talks At Convention Rally Sunday

Browder, Foster, Flynn Will Join in Garden Opening Night

Angelo Herndon, national chairman of the Young Communist League, will speak at a victory celebration at Madison Square Garden on Sunday evening, May 2, at 7:30 p. m. under the auspices of the Eighth National Convention of the Young Communist League.

More than 1,000 delegates and observers from every section of the country are expected to convene here for the convention from May 2 to May 5, the official arrangements committee announced.

The opening session of the convention will be held in Madison Square Garden with thousands of young spectators participating in the celebration of the annual Labor May Day which will take place one day prior to the meeting.

Leading Communist figures will address the youthful delegates.

Earl Browder, general secretary of the Communist Party, who is now enroute to this country from a European tour that included the Soviet Union, will make his first public appearance on his return at the convention.

Highlighting the program will be addresses by prominent labor leaders. William Z. Foster, chairman of the Communist Party, and Elizabeth Gurley Flynn, famous textile strike leader, who is making her first public appearance at a large scale meeting as a member of the Communist Party, will speak.

Presiding as convention chairman is Angelo Herndon. Other outstanding youth leaders who will speak at the Garden include Gil Green, national secretary of the Young Communist League and John Little, New York State secretary of the Young Communist League.
